To that spot down by the river,

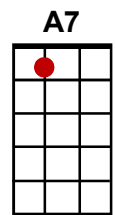
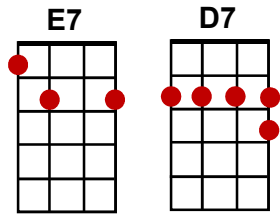
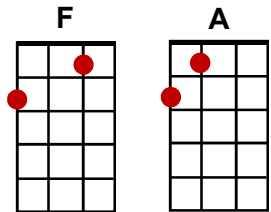
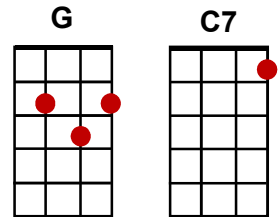
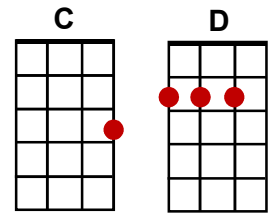
