

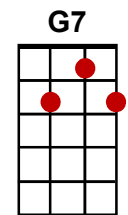
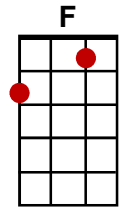
# Oom-Pah-Pah

(from the musical "Oliver" by Lionel Bart)

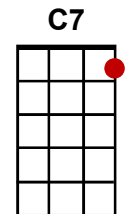

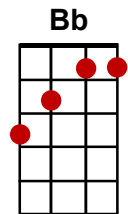
F G7

Will tell you just exactly what you want to hear.



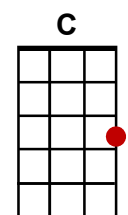
CHORUS: F G7

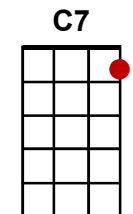
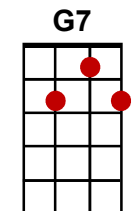
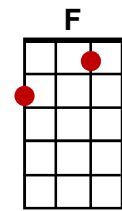
## Oom-Pah-Pah (Cont'd)

 Whether it's hidden, or whether it shows,

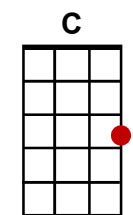
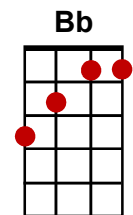
**C** **C7** **F** **C7**
