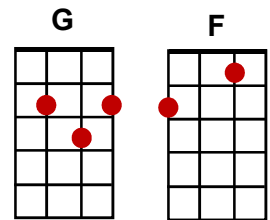

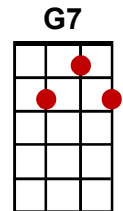
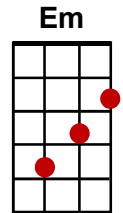

INTRO: **G / F / Em / G7 /**

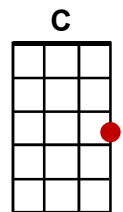
C **F**

Why d'you do me this way.



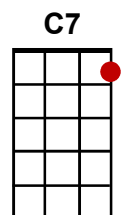
C **F**
