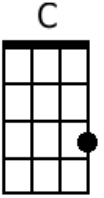


# Calypso Carol

(Michael Perry, 1964)

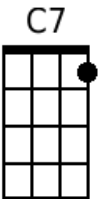
**INTRO (Calypso rhythm):** Rolling C

**CHORUS:**

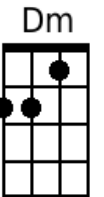
F C G7 C

**Verse 2:**

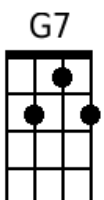
C Dm G7 C
