Shovel all the coal in, gotta keep it rolling,

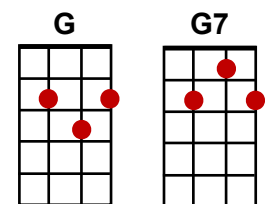
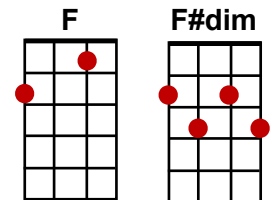
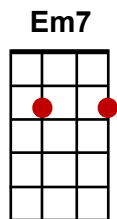
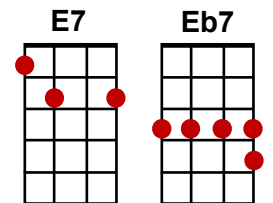
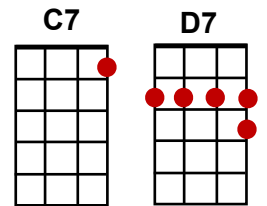
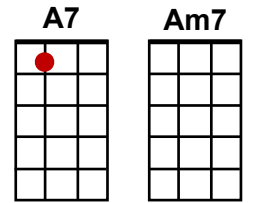
