Frosty the Snowman knew the sun was hot that day

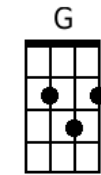
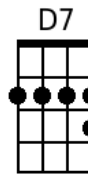
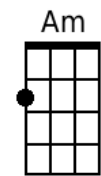
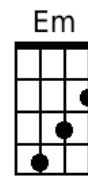
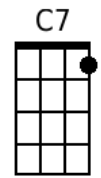
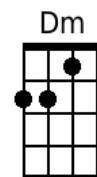
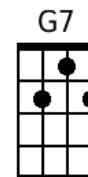
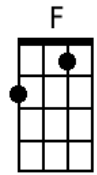
