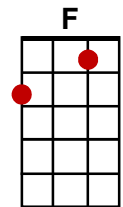
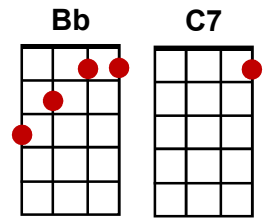
# Happiness (Cont'd)
