And the only time that he's satisfied

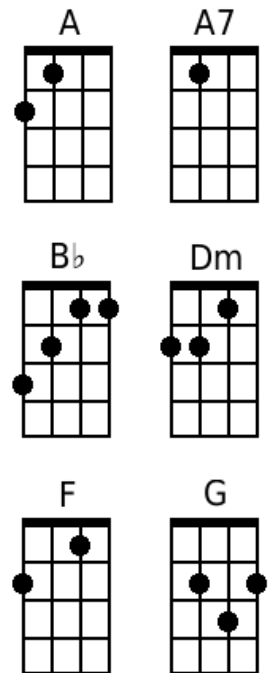
Dm A7 Dm A7
