So just look at them and sigh.....igh.....igh

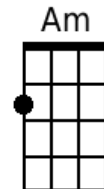
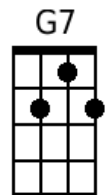
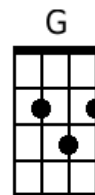
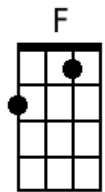

They seek the truth ... before they can die.



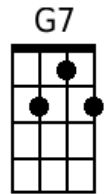
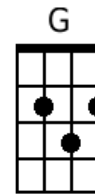
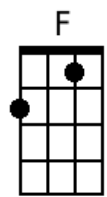
Teach Your Children (Cont'd)
